Figure 1: Field Layout

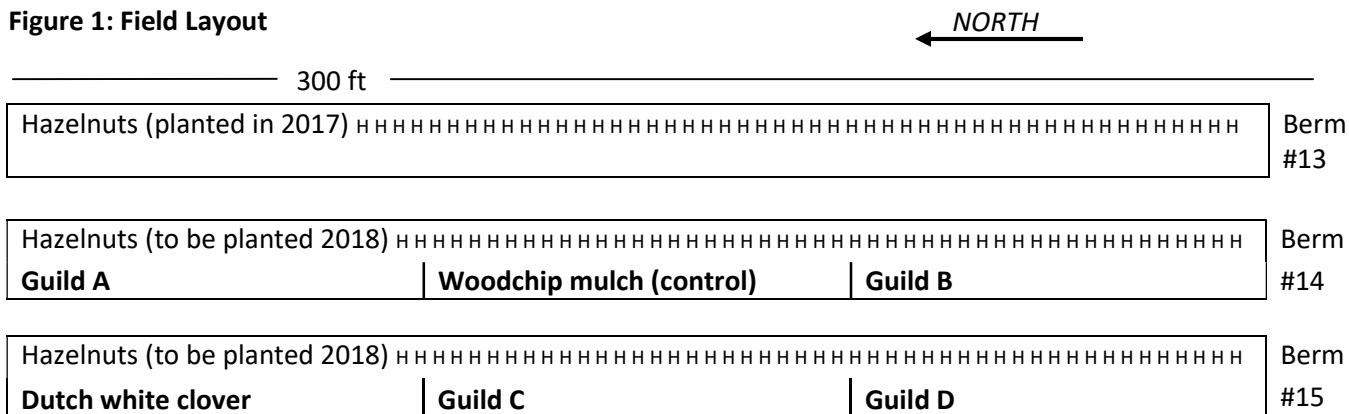


Figure 2: Example Guild A "Aromatic"

Key: H = Hazelnut chv = chives thy = thyme lav = lavender

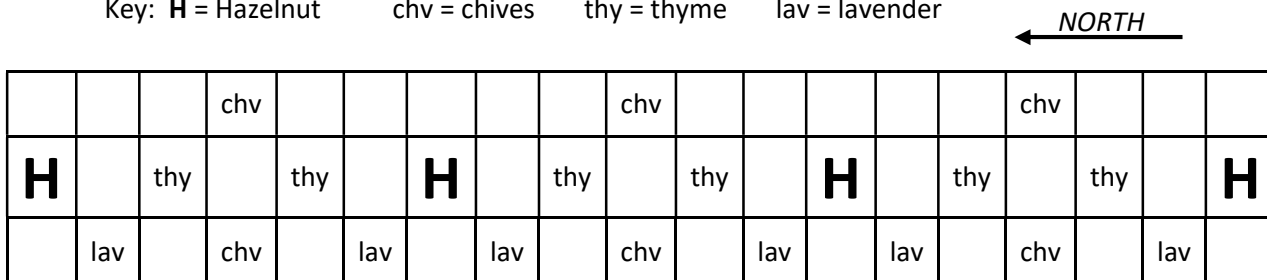
